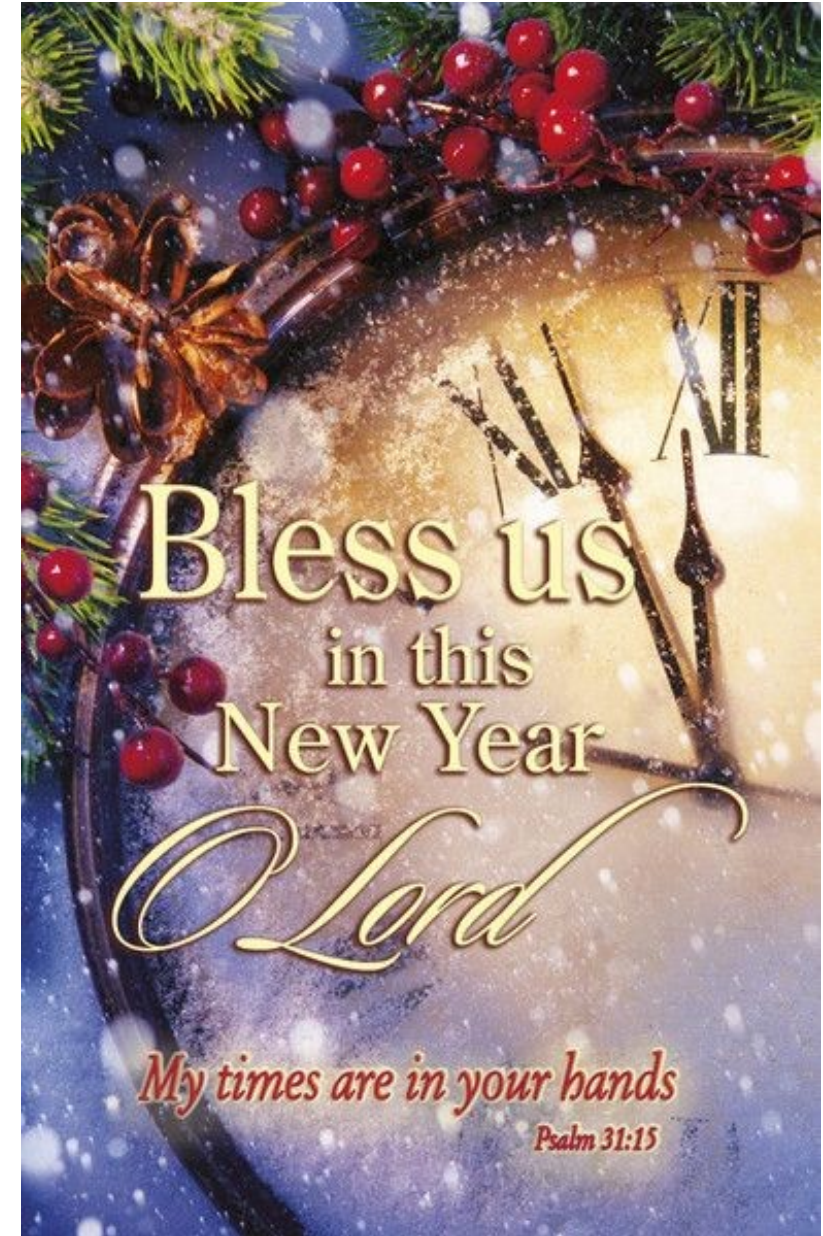

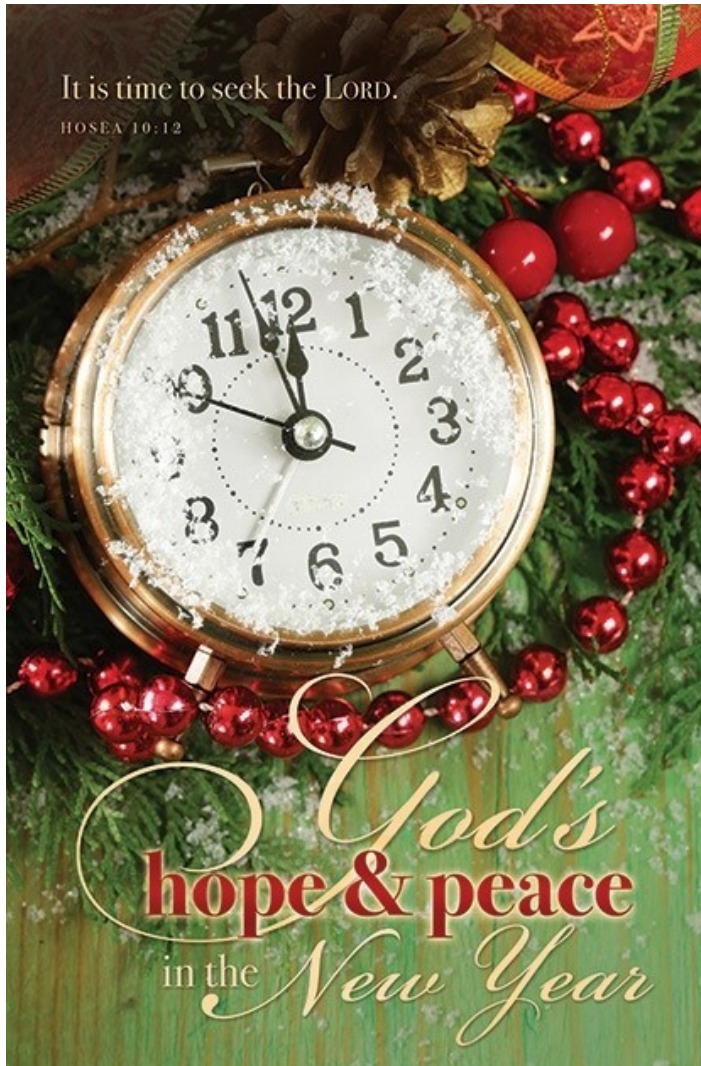

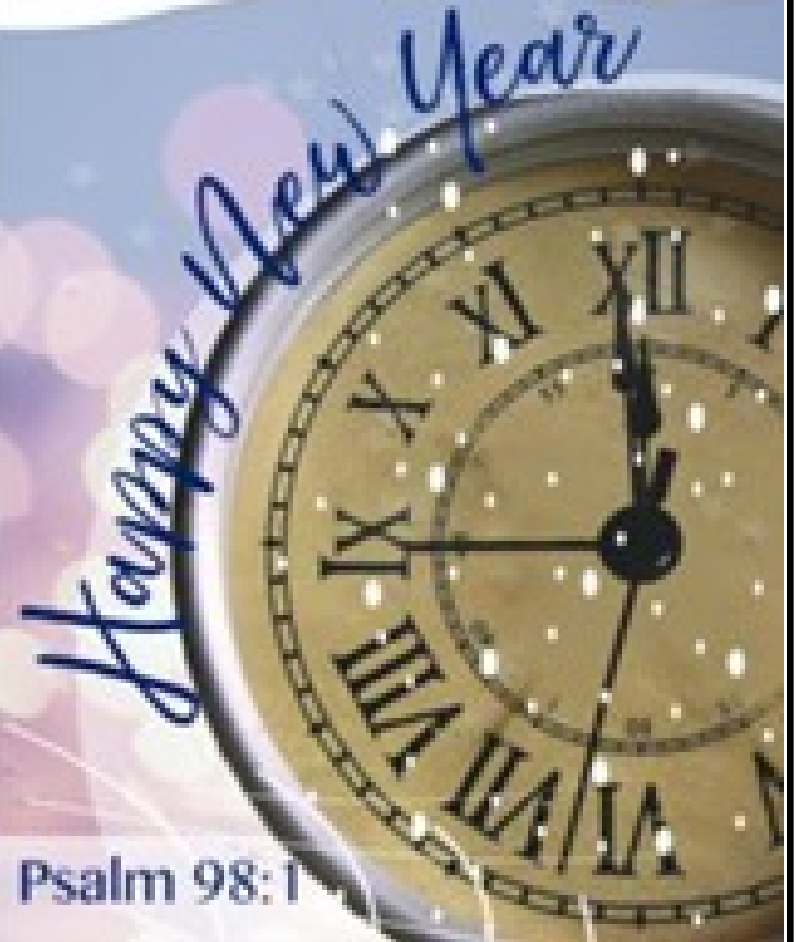
There is a redeemer
