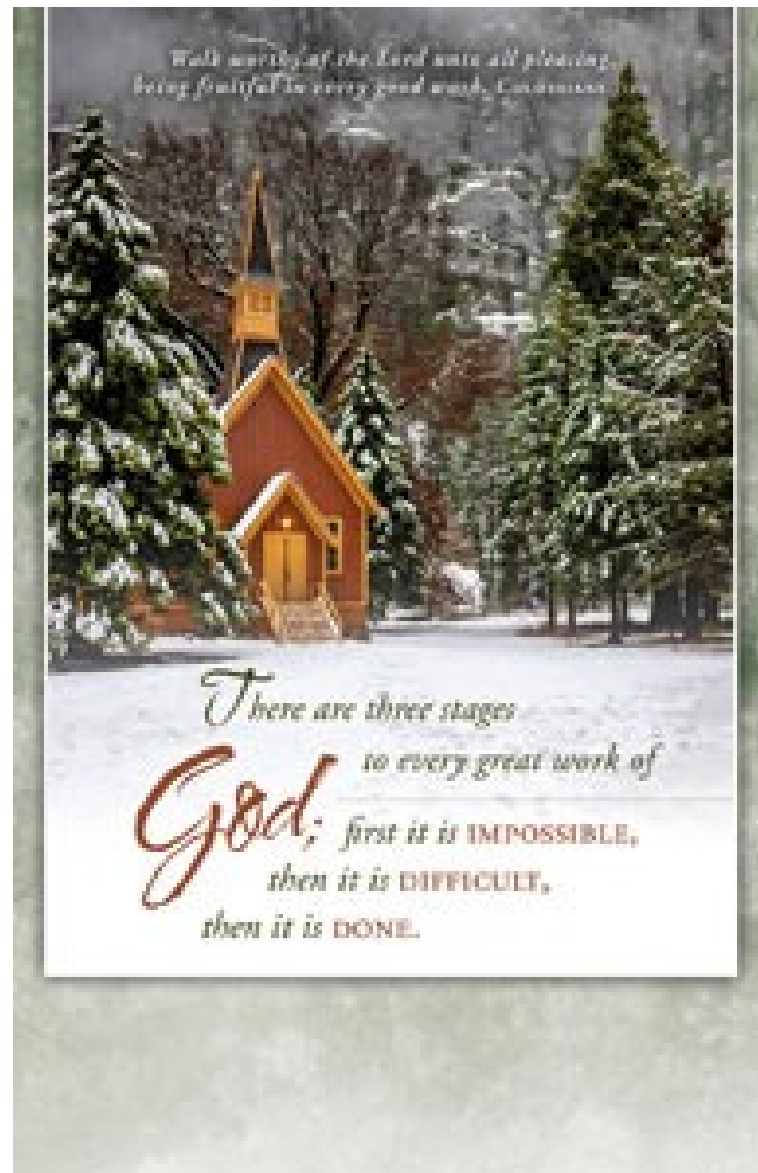

MISSION MOMENTS

DAILY PRAYER TOPICS

Sunday, January 21 – Give thanks that the 2012 Hakka Bible is sold out. Pray that churches and seekers in Taiwan may use it well and that God may guide our missionary, Paul McLean, and the Hakka team as they prepare a slightly revised version in a new Hakka-Han format.

Monday, January 22 – Pray for wisdom as presbyteries choose the person whom they believe God to be calling as the moderator of the 2024 General Assembly. Pray also for the youth at Westminster Presbyterian Church in Barrie, Ontario, that they may develop faithful friendships, be built up in biblical faith, and be equipped to be the hands and feet of Jesus in the community and wider world.
