

DAILY PRAYER TOPICS

Sunday, February 4 – Presbyterian World Service and Development Sunday – Pray that the Holy Spirit may stir up His church to work for a sustainable, compassionate, and just world, and to provide the resources needed when emergencies arise around the world.

Monday, February 5 – Pray for the congregation of Côte des Neiges Presbyterian Church, Montreal, Quebec, as they seek a legal decision regarding ownership of their church property. Pray that the decision would come quickly and would honour the history of the congregation which preceded the existence of The Presbyterian Church in Canada.

Tuesday, February 6 – Grace West Hill Presbyterian Church, Scarborough, Ontario, is engaged in strategic planning because of many changes affecting the congregation. Pray for discernment and God's guidance as the leadership seeks direction for the congregation.

Wednesday, February 7 – Give thanks for all who attend Bridlewood Presbyterian Church, Scarborough, Ontario, Wednesday evening Bible studies via Zoom. Pray for increased knowledge of the Scriptures, a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ, and for Pastor Joseph Choi as he leads the study.

Thursday, February 8 – Pray for God to bless all the teams which are revising and translating the Bible into some of Taiwan's indigenous languages: 'Amis, Cou, Ngudradrekai (Maolin, Wanshan and Tona dialects), Paiwan, Pinuyumayan, Sediq-Toda, and Tao.)
