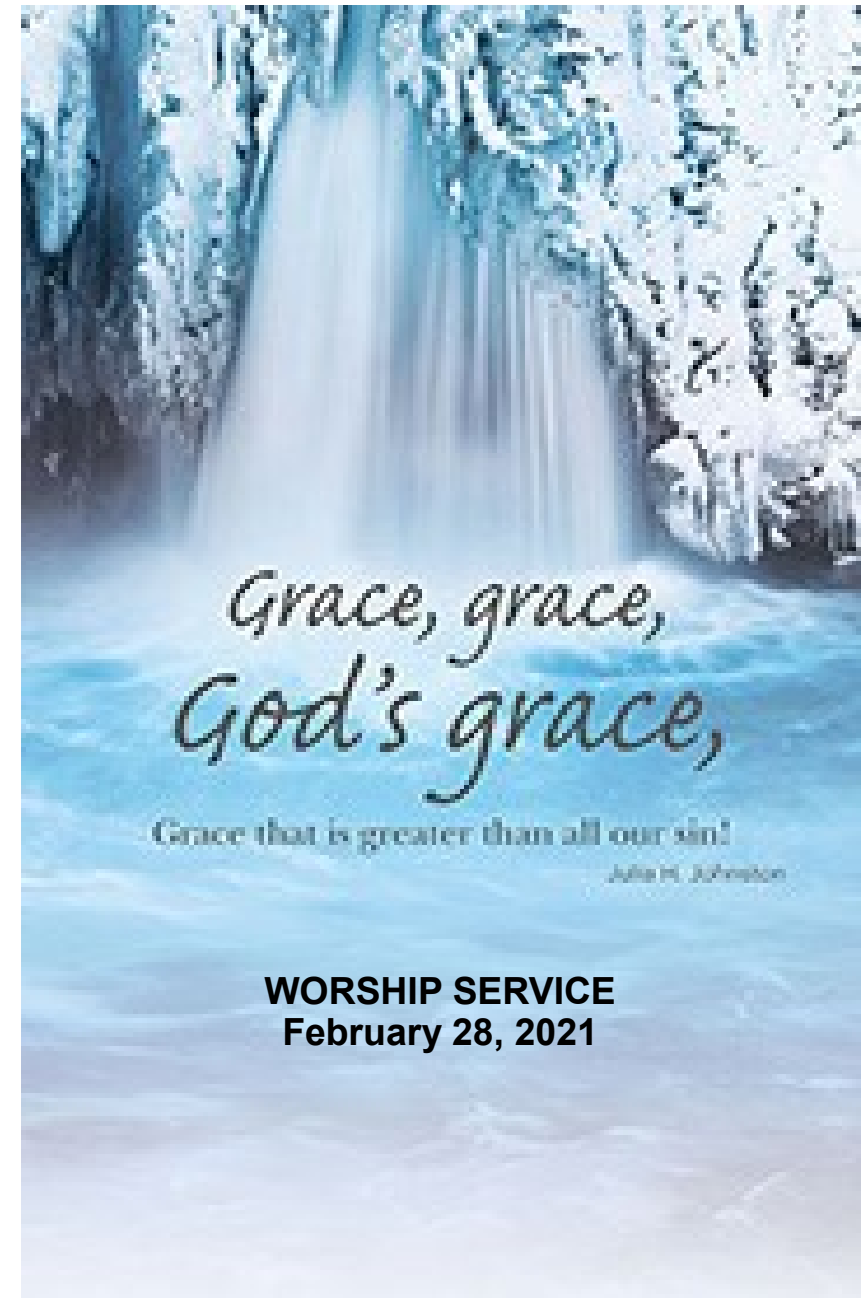

### **Hygiene Kits Protect Families in Nicaragua**

“As a family, we try to take all the necessary measures, like covering our nose when sneezing, avoiding shaking hands or going places where there might be large crowds. For many of the families in our community, it’s not possible to acquire protection materials like face masks, gloves, hand sanitizer or cleaning materials due to rising prices in the market. We are so thankful for all of you and the help you bring to our community.” Like many in Nicaragua, María struggles to access proper protection materials and cleaning products due to the COVID-19 pandemic. **Presbyterian World Service & Development**, through local partners, is helping people like María and her whole community, receive hygiene and sanitation items, ensuring they are prepared to safely face the pandemic.



## **OUR MISSIONARIES UPDATE**

**“Commit thy way unto the Lord; trust also in him, and he shall bring it to pass.” Psalm 37:5**

**Thank you for your prayers for our Ministry here in Nigeria and what the Lord has been doing through us.** Prayer is a fellowship between the children of God and their Maker. It is something you cannot do without because Jesus Christ couldn’t do without prayer. Beloved, at a point in His life when things became difficult, He prayed so much that His sweat became as drops of blood (Luke 22:44). As a child of God, when you leave prayer out of your life you are inviting in the devil and his cohorts of darkness. They love to dine with Christians who do not pray, in order to make their lives miserable.

Beloved, always commit whatever you want to do into God’s hand in prayer; trust and have faith in Him, and He will do it for you. This was the psalmist’s formula for receiving from God, and it will work for you. A simple prayer of faith is all that God requires to release His blessings to you (Mark 9:23). There is nothing too little to pray about; he wants to know everything you have on your mind. Don’t see the moment of prayer as always asking God to do something for you. See it as a fellowship, where you meet Him to have an intimate relationship with Him so that you can know His mind concerning you, your family, business, church, community, and the state. It is time to make your prayer life meaningful.

Continue to pray for us and with us as we seek more ways to accomplish our kingdom mandate.

### **Praise and Prayer**

- Thank God with us for a successful month of January in this new year. The Lord kept us even as some of our staff, including myself, were down with fever, malaria and typhoid but the Lord has healed and restored us all. Glory to His name.
- Thank God for saving one of our Magdalene girls from a ghastly motor accident on her way back from the learning centre. She was with her mates when a vehicle’s brakes failed while descending a hill. It was a chain reaction collision. She was in the fourth vehicle. She hit her and passed out. She has a deep cut on her head but is alive and getting better. Pray that there will not be a repeat of such incidents throughout their training.
- Pray for our nursery and primary school at Mbashoho as they embark on the construction of their school building. They had a fund-raiser which gave them some money to start building. Pray for divine provision for the completion of this project of theirs.

• Pray with us as well as we are set to embark on the construction of the foot-bridge for our School at Ndi Obasi. It is important to conclude this project this month before the rains set in by next month. Pray for provision to enable us to complete it.

• Our first board meeting for the year where we will set up and ratify our programmes and budget for the year is on the 20th of this month. Pray for fruitful deliberation and safety in travels for our board members as they come from various places.

• Our next LeadersFor training is March 1-4. Pray for the participants as we prepare for the meeting through the reviews, and also for the safety of all during these times. Pray for smooth internet connectivity during the sessions and better grasping of the techniques being expounded.

• Pray against this resurgence of COVID-19 and its plans. Declare the cessation of the second wave and that it will be halted by the power of the Holy Spirit. Pray against the plans for the new world order unless the coming of Christ is at hand. Pray for the church to be ready for the rapture and for more opportunities for us to reach more souls and bring them into the Kingdom of God before the rapture happens.

• Pray that the government will not close down our clinic. Due to the pandemic, our doctor left for his home and never returned, just to call us and inform us that he has resigned. It is always difficult to secure the services of a doctor due to the remote nature of the place and the low salary we are able to offer. Join us to pray that the Lord will provide a called doctor for this missions clinic.

• We thank God for the provisions for the purchase of computers for our high school over 10 years ago. The computers need to be changed now as all but one of them has packed up and the students can no longer do their practical. Pray for the provision to purchase 10 computers for the computer lab for our high school which has started the academic activities since January.

• Continue to pray for our Bible college that it will fulfill its mandate for the season and for being established. Thank God for the resource persons lecturing at the school for safety during travels and protection from all harms. Pray also for the students for wisdom and understanding of the lectures.

Thanks to you for standing with us in this move of God through us. Your prayers have been very effective this year and we are seeing the results, so do not give up on petitioning heaven for our sake. Remain blessed!
