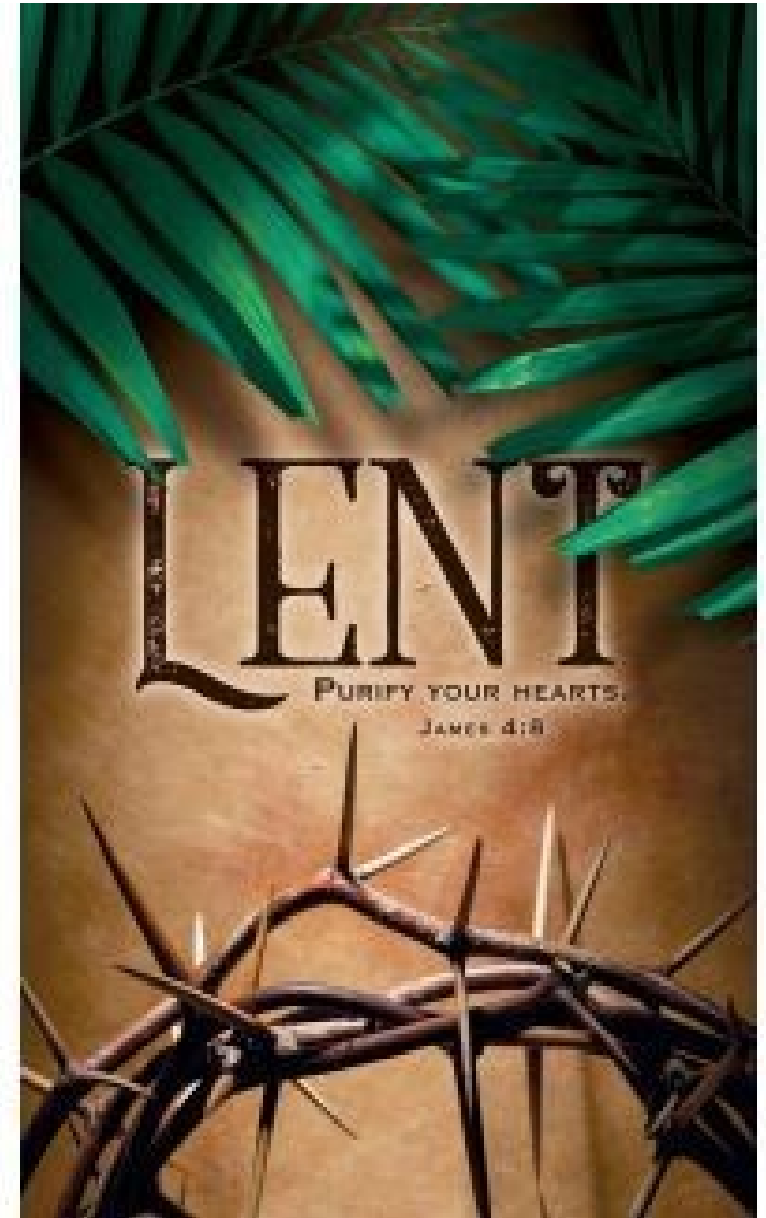


Tuesday, March 22 (World Water Day) We give thanks for the sacred gift of water. Let us work to ensure that all people have access to safe water in Canada and abroad.
