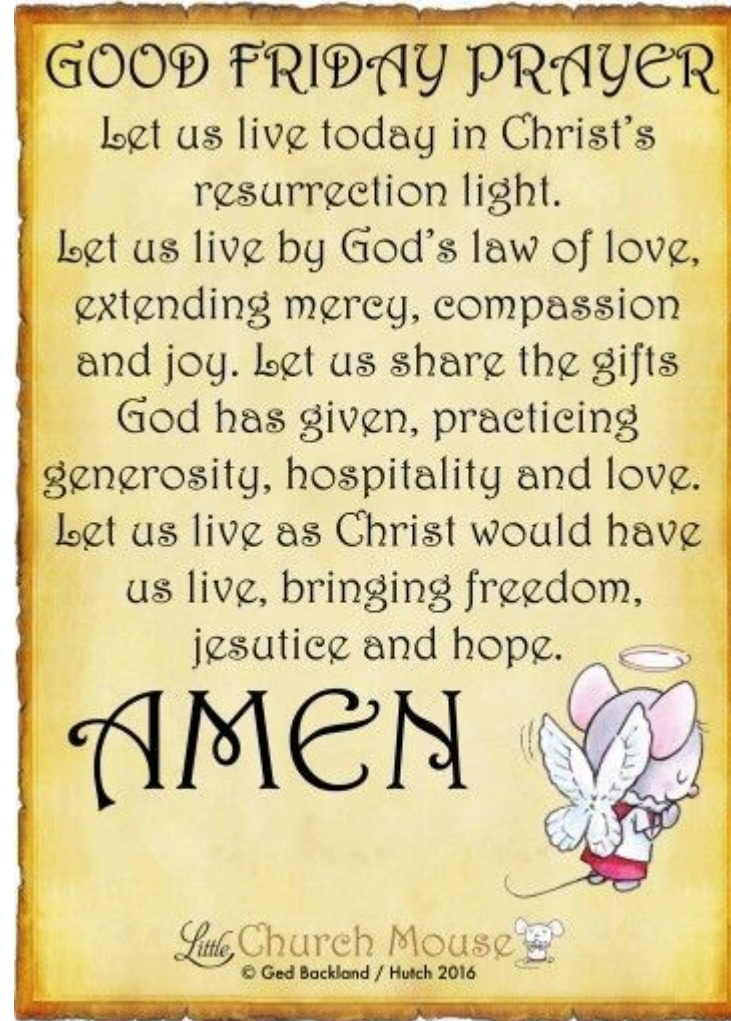
GRIEF SUPPORT
