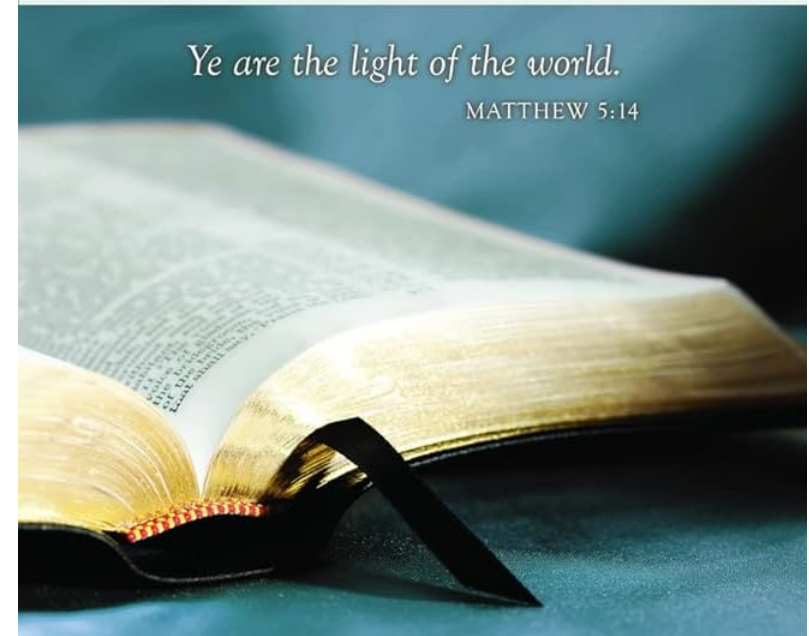

MISSION MOMENTS

Sunday, April 21 2024

In the Kushkak village in Afghanistan, 42-year-old Guljan lived a simple life with her husband and four children until one day in October 2023, when an earthquake struck their village. Guljan lost her husband and 11-year-old son. After the disaster, she encountered significant challenges in getting assistance due to the gender disparities present in her village. However, PWS&D's partner recognized her needs and provided Guljan's family with a winterized tent to help endure the harsh weather conditions. PWS&D provided food assistance, as well as other support after the earthquake to help people survive the winter challenges.

GRIEF SUPPORT

St. Andrew's, Scarborough is hosting a 13-week **GriefShare** support group, from April 4th to June 27th on Thursday mornings from 10:30 a.m. until noon.

"**GriefShare** provides a safe place where individuals can find hope and healing after the death of a loved one. **GriefShare** is a seminar/small support group ministry. It consists of videos, discussion time, and participant workbooks that guide group members through each session. Our **GriefShare** group will have three leaders, and three small discussion groups. It is designed for people who are grieving the death of loved ones and feel that being a part of a small group would be helpful. It is meant as an outreach for anyone who is grieving and not only for church members.

Friday, April 26 – Pray for Melissa Horkins as she facilitates the *Intergenerational Group* at St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church, Parry Sound, Ontario, that this program may bring together all generations of God's family through shared meals and activities to break down barriers between the generations and foster impactful relationships.

Saturday, April 27 – Spring has arrived and things are green and growing. Pray for our farmers and their families, especially the small farm operations struggling to keep going, that God may show them the way forward and bless them.
