



MISSION MOMENTS

The Reformed Parish in Csap/Chop, a congregation of the Reformed Church in Transcarpathia in western Ukraine, has been providing temporary shelter and food for people displaced by the war. Their social kitchen program includes hot food delivery to elderly congregation members who live alone and are unable to cook for themselves. With limited resources, Bishop Zan-Fabian reached out to the PCC for financial support to continue this ministry of care. The PCC provided a grant from Presbyterians Sharing, fulfilling the law of Christ to bear one another's burdens.

GRIEF SUPPORT

St. Andrew's, Scarborough is hosting a 13-week **GriefShare** support group, from April 4th to June 27th on Thursday mornings from 10:30 a.m. until noon.

"GriefShare provides a safe place where individuals can find hope and healing after the death of a loved one. GriefShare is a seminar/small support group ministry. It consists of videos, discussion time, and participant workbooks that guide group members through each session. Our GriefShare group will have three leaders, and three small discussion groups. It is designed for people who are grieving the death of loved ones and feel that being a part of a small group would be helpful. It is meant as an outreach for anyone who is grieving and not only for church members.
