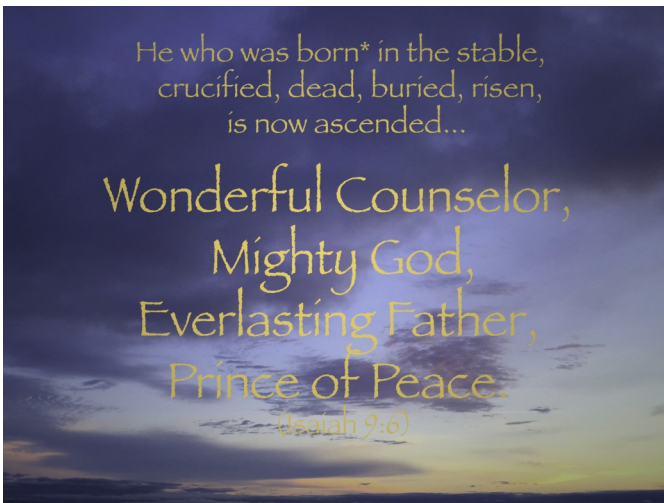

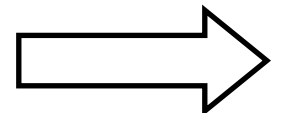

MISSION MOMENTS

Sunday, May 12, 2024

Somalia faces an acute hunger crisis, worsened by the most severe drought in four decades. With failed crops, widespread water shortages and reduced livestock productivity, Nafiso Hussein's family and thousands more had to abandon their homes in search of relief. Hunger and extreme conditions affected Nafiso's son Hadi, whose health had deteriorated critically. In the displaced persons camp where they had sought refuge, Hadi was quickly referred to the stabilization centre for treatment, and under this initiative, his health significantly improved. Nafiso is grateful for her son's recovery, "He is well now, and I am happy to see him play and laugh like before." PWS&D, with partners at Canadian Foodgrains Bank, provides funding to train community nutrition workers who identify and screen severely malnourished children.

GRIEF SUPPORT

St. Andrew's, Scarborough is hosting a 13-week **GriefShare** support group, from April 4th to June 27th on Thursday mornings from 10:30 a.m. until noon.

"**GriefShare** provides a safe place where individuals can find hope and healing after the death of a loved one. **GriefShare** is a seminar/small support group ministry. It consists of videos, discussion time, and participant workbooks that guide group members through each session. Our **GriefShare** group will have three leaders, and three small discussion groups. It is designed for people who are grieving the death of loved ones and feel that being a part of a small group would be helpful. It is meant as an outreach for anyone who is grieving and not only for church members.

DAILY PRAYER TOPICS

Sunday, May 12 – Christian Family Sunday/Mother's Day – Pray for parents today facing greater challenges than ever, seeking to raise godly and faithful children.

Friday, May 17 – Pray for Norman Kennedy Presbyterian Church, Regina, Saskatchewan, as their vacancy began in February, that the Session and the Interim Moderator, the Rev. Ryan Bak, may establish a good working relationship and may proceed with wisdom on the paths of caring for the congregation in the present and of seeking new leadership for the future.

Saturday, May 18 – Pray for wisdom for the leaders in the Han-Ca presbyteries as they consider their future ministries, that the Holy Spirit may be their guide.
