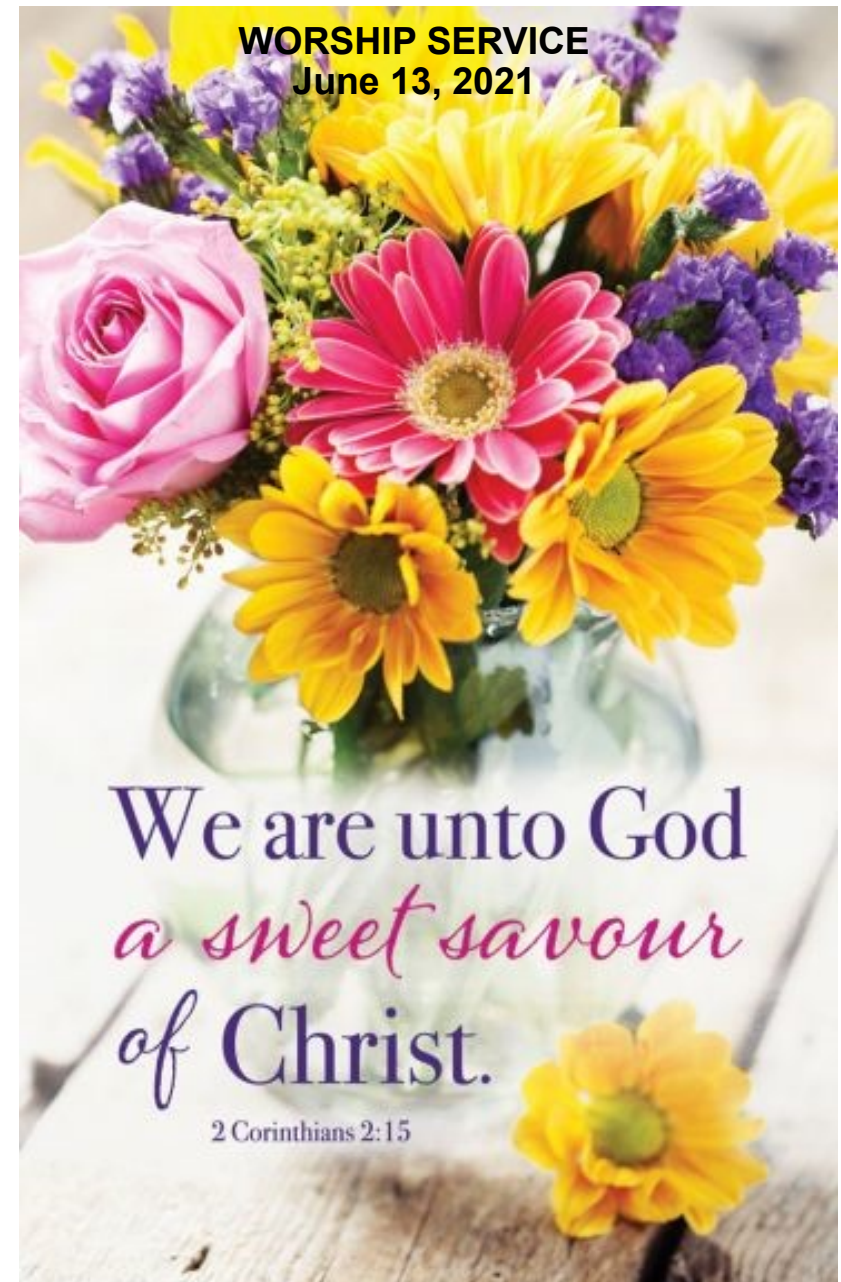

Meeting the Needs of Families in Beirut

The massive explosion that struck the city of Beirut in August 2020 left many people injured and many homes damaged. **Presbyterian World Service & Development (PWS&D)** responded to the devastating effects by meeting the needs of vulnerable people in Lebanon. Families received essential supplies, such as food and hygiene items, to sustain them as they started to rebuild. Additionally, PWS&D assisted in restoring homes and schools and provided water and sanitation kits to families, as well as school kits to children.

DAILY PRAYERS

Sunday, June 13 We pray for people elected to serve in government and that those with power will have wisdom and that those who are wise will have power.

Monday, June 14 We pray for those who work to provide food that strengthens our bodies so that we can love and serve God and one another.

Tuesday, June 15 We pray for vulnerable families affected by COVID-19 in Afghanistan who are receiving food assistance from Presbyterian World Service & Development.

Wednesday, June 16 We pray for the Moderator of the 2021 General Assembly as a new term of pastoral ministry and leadership begins.

Thursday, June 17 We pray for wisdom and discernment as the Rev. Patrick Thegu Mutahi begins his three-year term as Moderator of the Presbyterian Church of East Africa (PCEA) in Kenya.

Friday, June 18 We pray for musicians, singers and artists who add beauty and texture to our worship of God.

Saturday, June 19 We give thanks and pray for teachers who have had to adapt to teaching under new and difficult circumstances.
