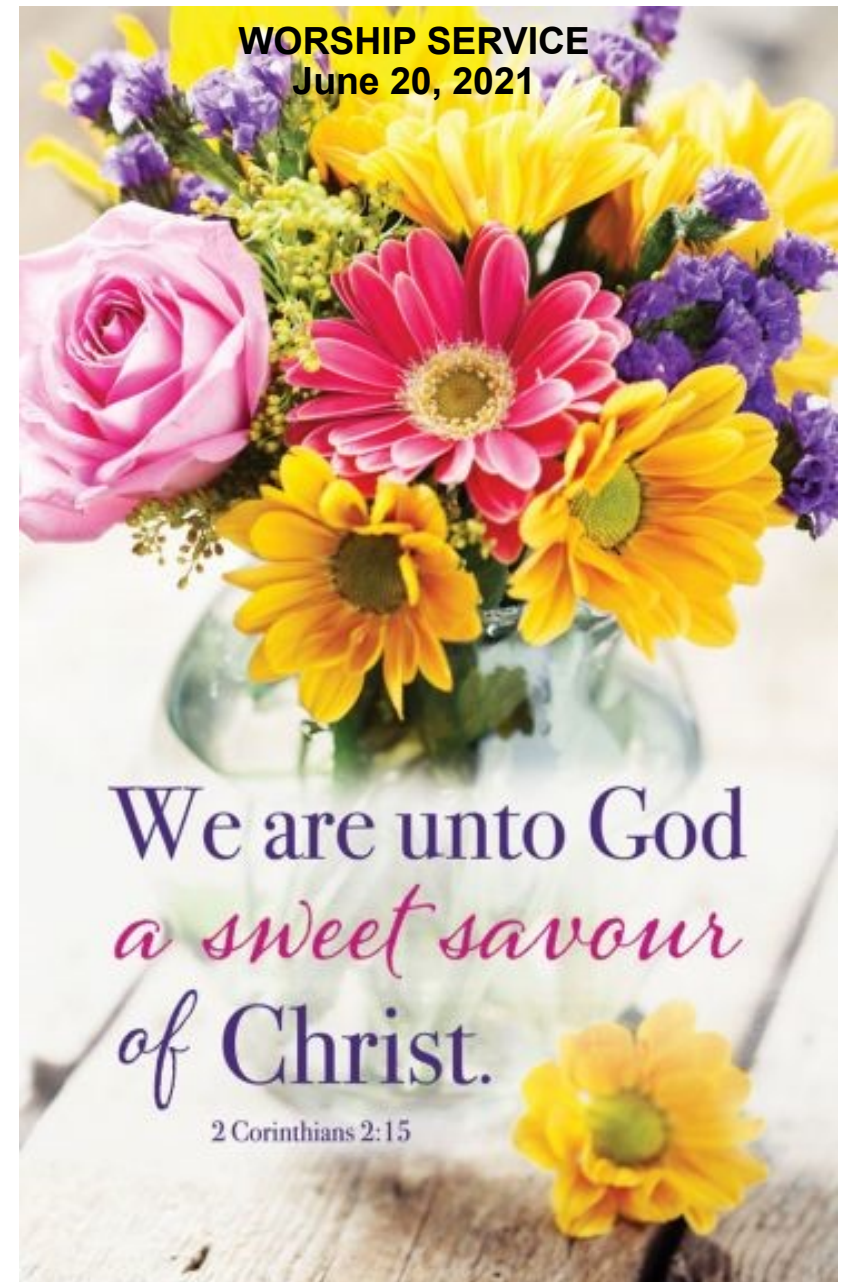

### **Sunday, June 20, 2021 -National Indigenous Peoples Day**

These ministries meet physical and spiritual needs by providing meals, counselling, temporary housing and employment assistance. They also strive to heal hearts through art and music therapy, worship services that incorporate Indigenous beliefs, and more.
