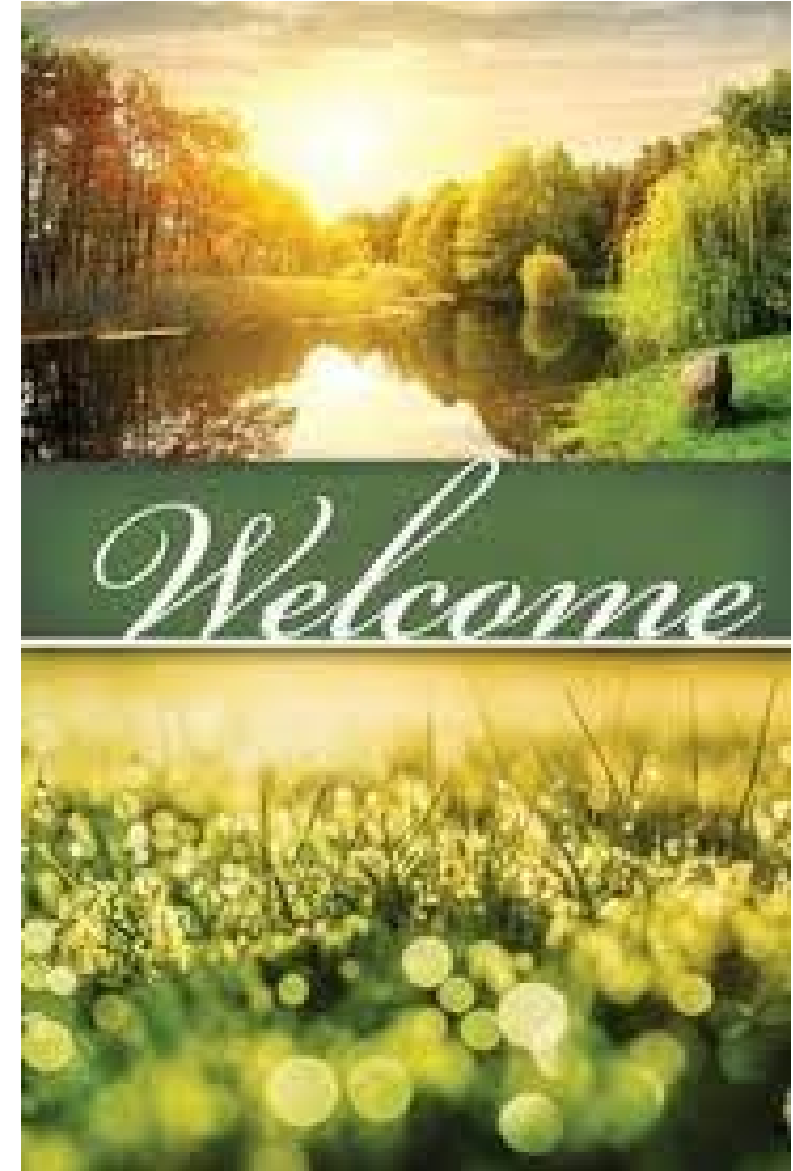

## **MISSION MOMENTS**

**SUNDAY, JULY 16, 2023**

After their summer crop failed and they lost their agricultural loan, Moolo and his wife Babbri, who live in Pakistan, were in financial trouble and were going hungry. Given the gravity of their situation, they managed to receive food assistance from **PWS&D's** partner in their community. The amount received was sufficient to cover some other basic needs and meant that the elderly couple could use their small savings to provide daily medication to their son Chandan, who has epilepsy. With their remaining savings, Moolo hoped to open a small store, but his eyesight was deteriorating. Babbri stepped up and opened the store herself, remarking, "It is because of this aid that we are not under debt, or we would have sold our goats to pay for food. But we are not in debt and still have our goats!"

## **DAILY PRAYER TOPICS**

**Sunday, July 16** – Pray for Richmond Presbyterian Church, Richmond, British Columbia, as they welcome their new minister, the Rev. Curtis Bablitz.

**Monday, July 17** – Thank God for the ongoing work of Indigenous Bible translation in Taiwan. Pray that Paul McLean's in-person visits to all the teams last month may bear good fruit.

**Tuesday, July 18** – Pray for retired ministers who carry heavy workloads as interim moderators and provide preaching and pastoral care in vacant congregations, that they may find opportunities to rest this summer.

**Wednesday, July 19** – Pray for the Rev. Steve Lindsay and wife Susan as he retires from full-time ministry at Cheyne Presbyterian Church, Stoney Creek, Ontario, that God may give them refreshment as they begin a new phase of ministry. Pray for the search committee as they seek the person that the Lord has chosen to lead Cheyne.

**Thursday, July 20** – Pray for the congregation of St. Mark's Presbyterian Church, Don Mills, Ontario, as they seek God's direction, and for their interim moderator, the Rev. Dr. Ian Clark.

**Friday, July 21** – Pray for the migrant labourers who are working on Canadian farms, that their health may be protected and that local churches may know best how to support and encourage them.

**Saturday, July 22** – Pray for full-time ministers in smaller presbyteries, especially in remote areas where some are interim moderators in congregations while also providing presbytery leadership, that they may be able to carve out a time of rejuvenation this summer.
