

The PCC's partnership with Theological Education by Extension in Malawi began 45 years ago when the Rev. It has opened doors for women and working church leaders who want to deepen their biblical and theological knowledge and be better equipped to serve. During these challenging times, the Rev. Chimwemwe Mitengo, Executive Director, is thankful for the PCC's continued partnership and support through **Presbyterians Sharing.**
