

MISSION MOMENTS

SUNDAY, JULY 30, 2023

Nadhifa, a single mother of seven in Somalia, had to relocate with her two oldest daughters and one-year-old son, Hamza, to a camp for internally displaced people after the drought caused her to lose her livelihood. She left her other four children behind with relatives, fearing for their survival. Nadhifa and her three children journeyed to the Dollow district to seek humanitarian assistance. During screening at the camp, Hamza was diagnosed with severe acute malnutrition. With the support of **PWS&D**, Hamza received treatment and recovered after a few weeks. In addition, Nadhifa participated in the infant and young child feeding community information session, where she gained valuable nutrition knowledge. "I feel relieved that my son's health has improved, and I can now search for work to provide food for my children," she shared.

DAILY PRAYER TOPICS

Sunday, July 30 – Pray for the more than 40 congregations that are in the search process for a minister, that the Holy Spirit may lead them to the ones who are called to serve among them. Pray, too, for Anita and others who are seeking a call.

Monday, July 31 – Pray for the congregations in the Presbytery of Westminster, British Columbia. Many of them are facing new challenges after the pandemic. Pray that they may be able to begin considering a new vision for their ministry. They need the leadership to do this, but they also need the presence of the Spirit and a great deal of courage.
