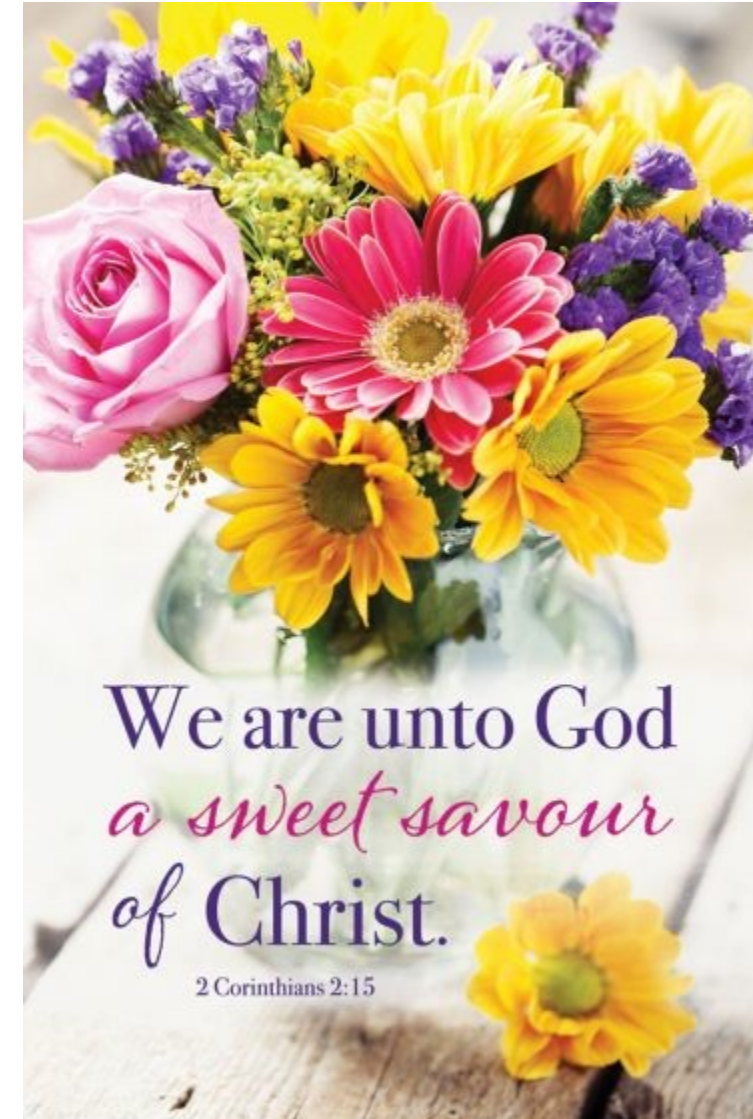

Thursday, August 18 We pray for the members and work of the Women’s Missionary Society.

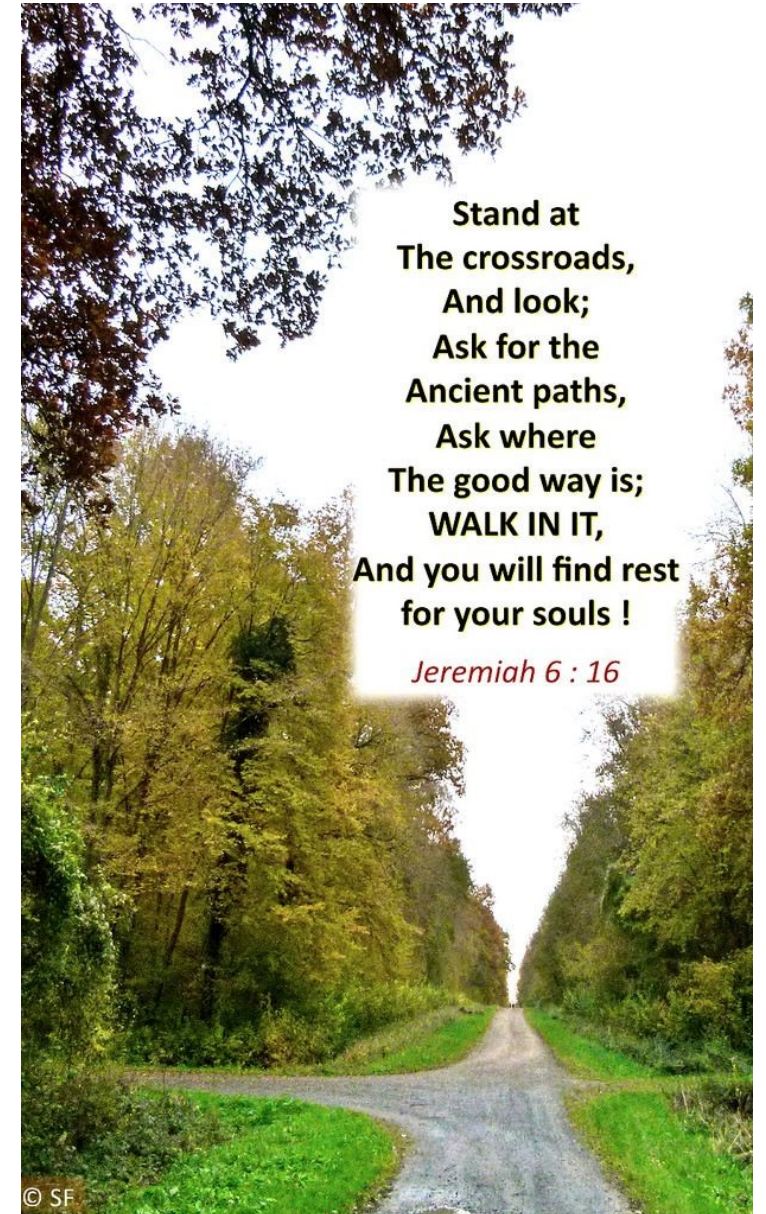
Friday, August 19 We pray that decision makers take steps to protect biodiversity in the earth’s ecosystems.
