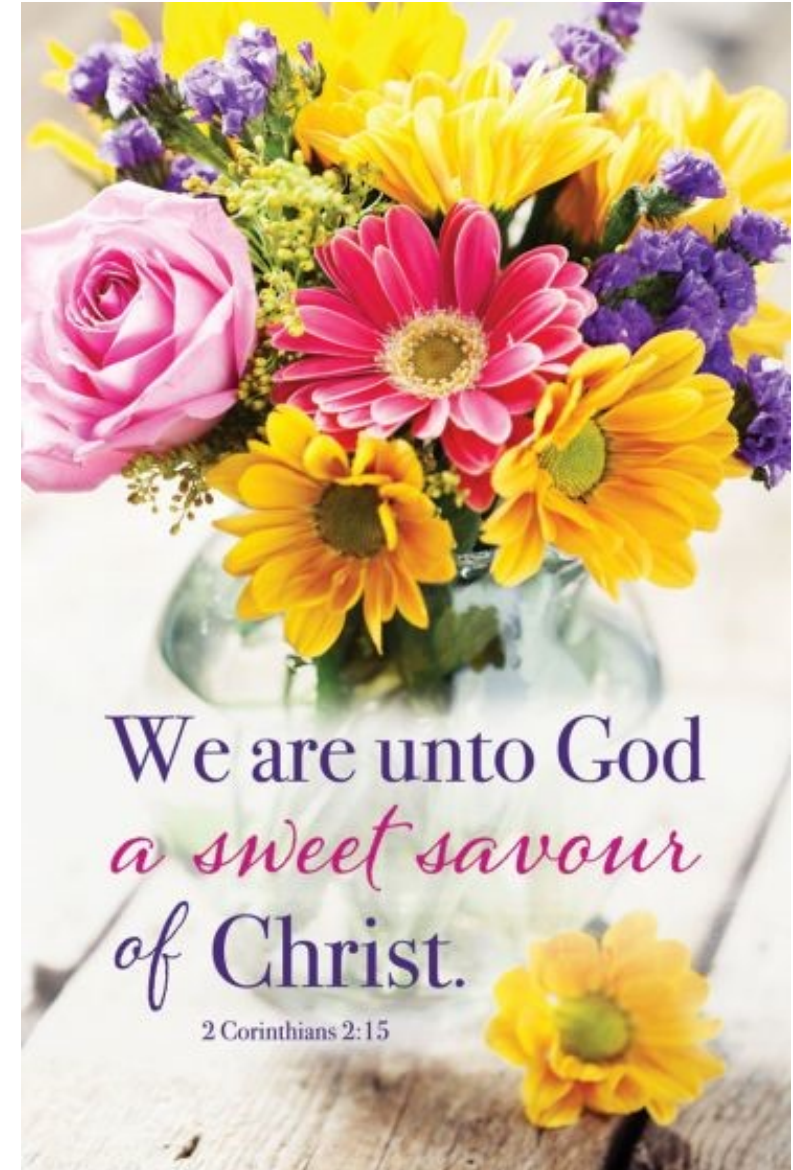

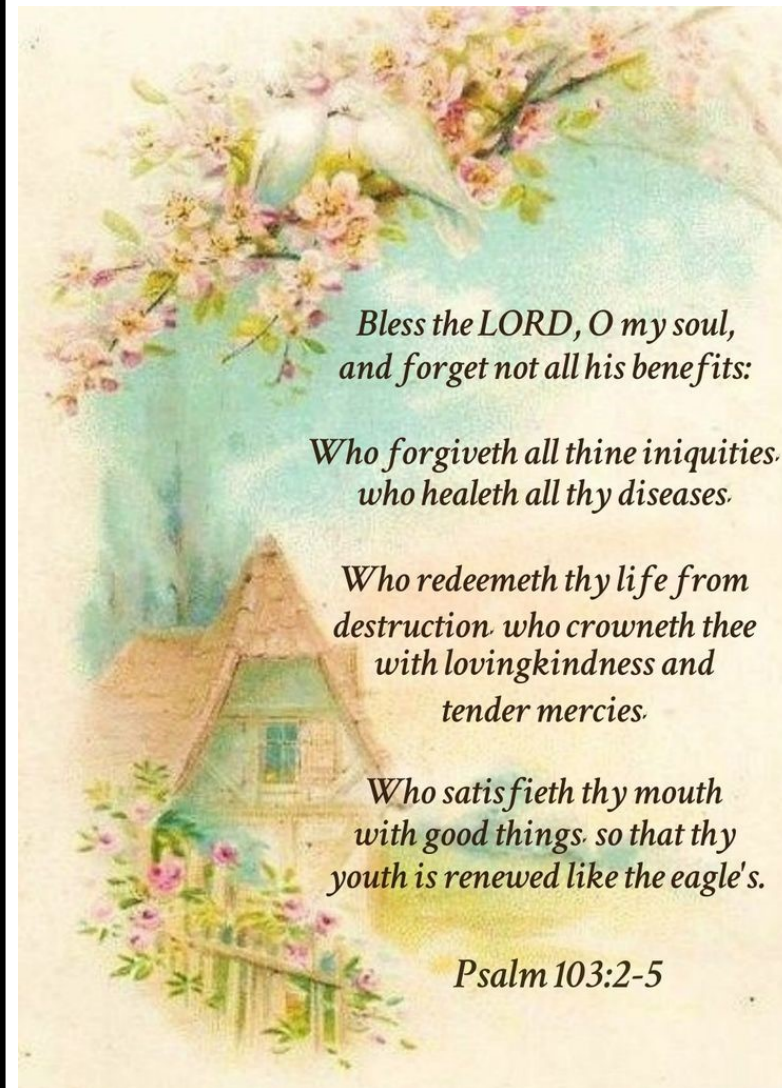
Friday, September 2 We pray for the people, ministries and mission of the Presbytery of Eastern Han-Ca.
