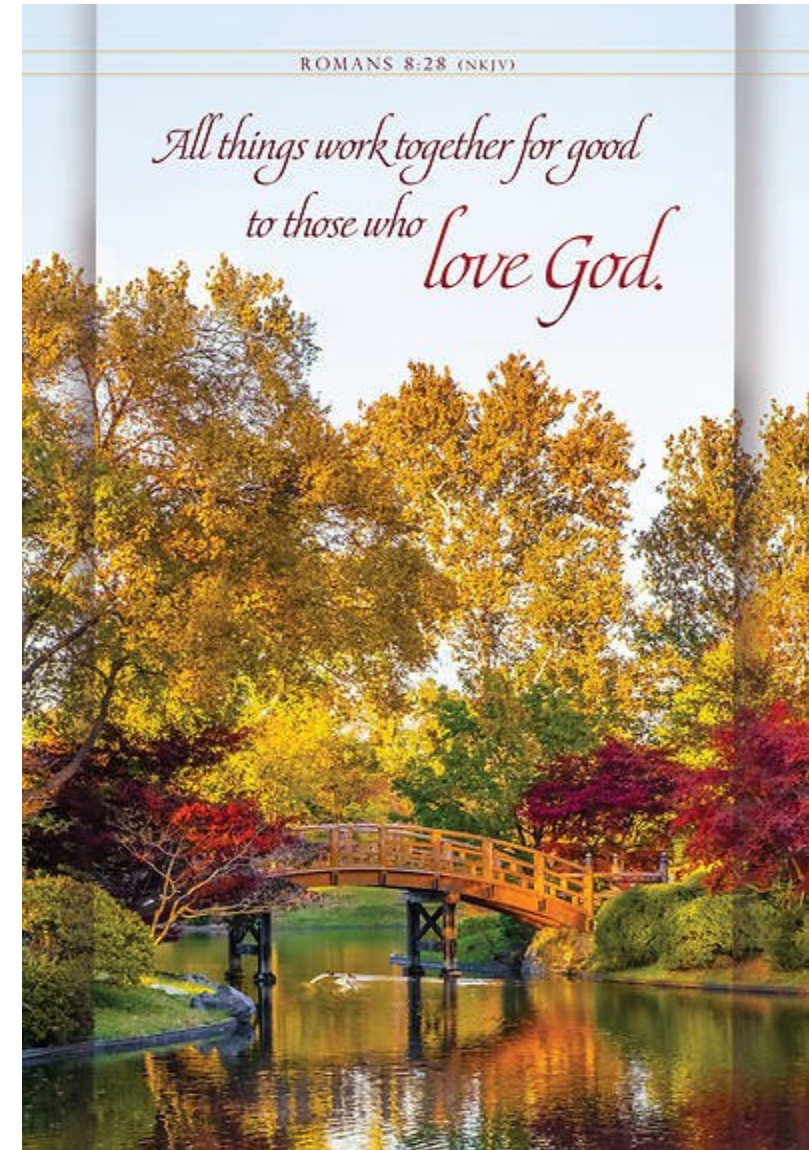

Thursday, September 29 We pray for ministers of our church as they continue in faithful ministry through challenging times.

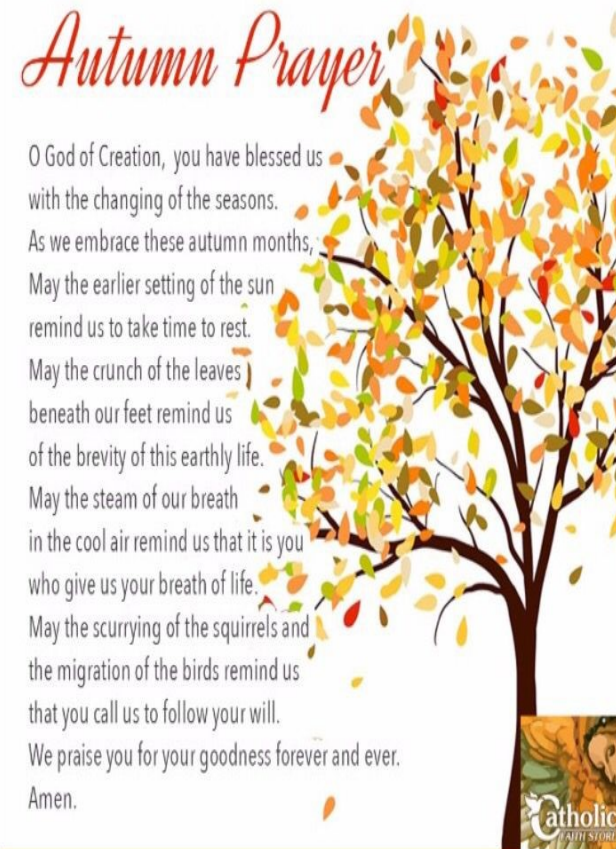
