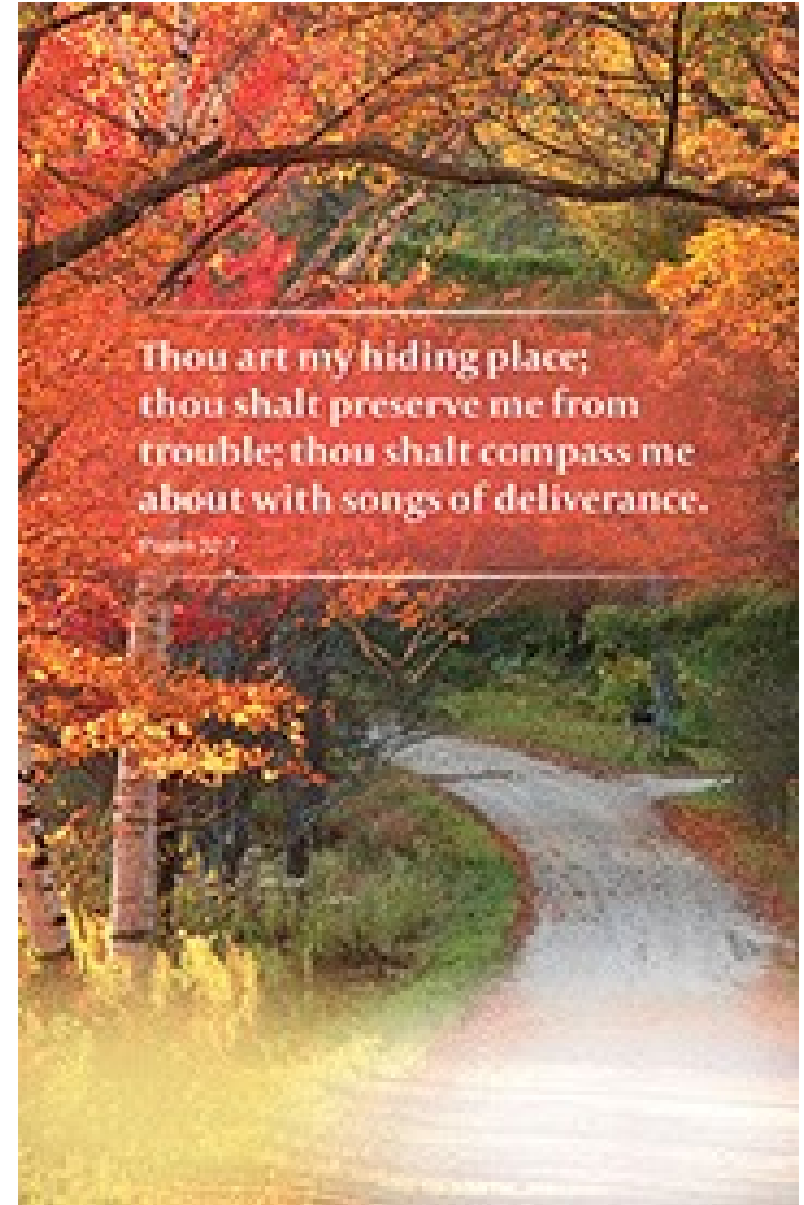

Mission moments

Sunday, OCTOBER 15, 2023

The hardening of the US sanctions and the global financial crisis are contributing to a shortage of food, fuel, clean water and medicine in Cuba. With partners' support, the Evangelical Seminary of Theology in Matanzas carries on, providing high quality, diversified theological education, and serving the community through diaconal projects. In 2022, the PCC helped improve the infrastructure for hybrid teaching and assisted with the renovation to the library and the Historical Archive. The Rev. Dr. Carlos Ham, Rector, shared at the 2023 General Assembly: "We appreciate the ways in which you accompany our work, not only providing much-needed financial support, but also through prayers."

DAILY PRAYER TOPICS

Friday, October 20 – Pray for Interim-Moderator, the Rev. Chris Little, and the elders of St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church, Tillsonburg, Ontario, as they continue to prepare updated mission and vision statements for the congregation.

Saturday, October 21 – Pray for Grace Presbyterian Church, Orleans, Ontario, as their pastor has just retired and their church musician is leaving for another position, that God may provide them with faithful pulpit supply speakers and musicians to lead worship as they move forward.
