

Monday, November 7 We give thanks for ecumenical councils that bring Christians from different denominations together to engage in fellowship, study and action.


Tuesday, November 8 We pray for students studying at Knox College in Toronto, Ontario. May God guide them in thinking deeply, living honestly, and leading courageously.
