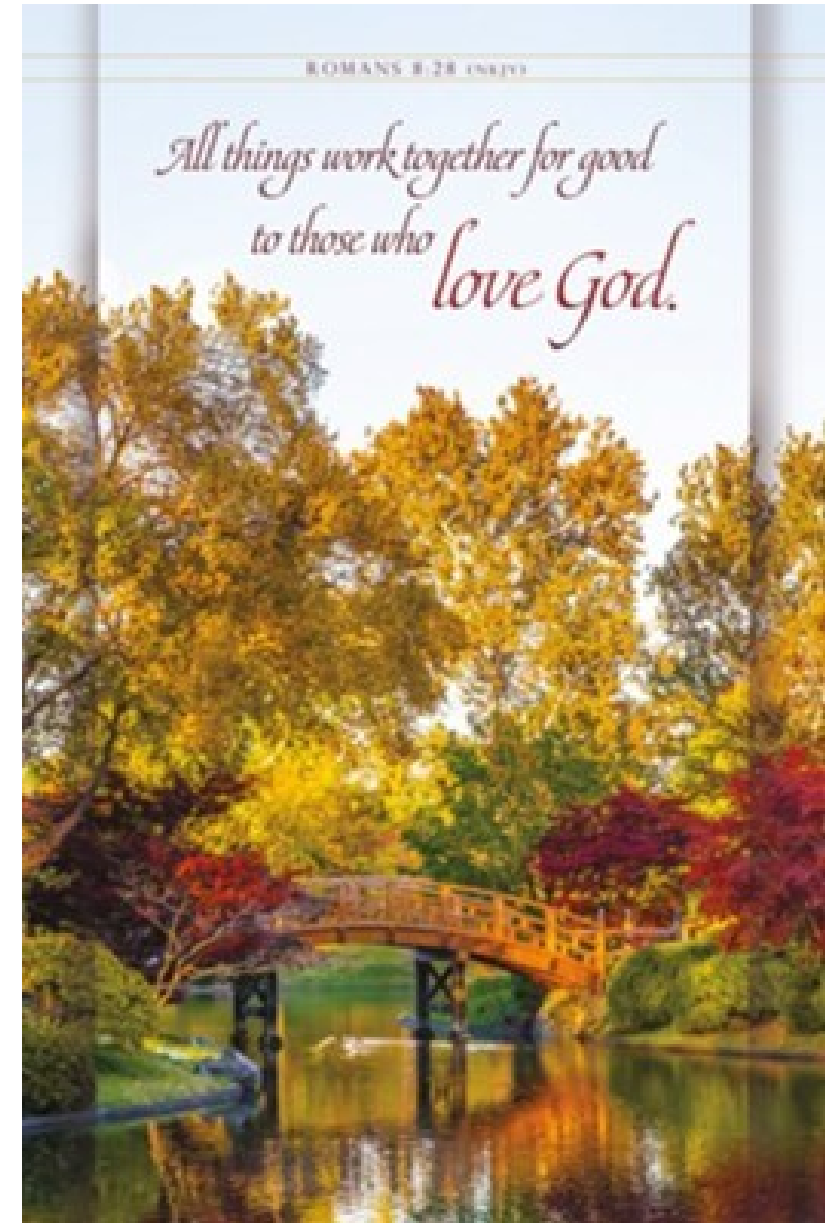

Protecting Children in Malawi

Ten-year-old Joseph lives with his family in northern Malawi. One day, Joseph showed up to school, not quite himself. His friends noticed and asked what was wrong. "My father and mother shout at each other and fight almost every week. Sometimes my father calls us bad names and chases us out of the house at night, for no reason," he said. His friends, who had learned about children's rights and what support was available to them urged him to speak to a Child Protection Worker. The Child Protection Worker understood the economic challenges that were exacerbating the abuse and connected the family with resources to address them. Together, the family is using what they have learned to build a more peaceful home. This project is supported by **Presbyterian World Service & Development**.

DAILY PRAYERS

Sunday, November 21 (Reign of Christ) Sovereign God, who rules all creation, you sent Jesus to testify to your truth. Help us to hear Christ's voice so that we can teach and work for his politics of justice, grace, peace and love.

Monday, November 22 (National Housing Day) We pray for all who are without homes, and that they may find shelter and God's love and peace.

Friday, November 26 We pray for the Presbytery of Assiniboia's Ministry Committee. May they feel a strong sense of God's presence to strengthen, focus and lead their discernment.

Saturday, November 27 We give thanks for programs the church supports through **Presbyterian World Service & Development** that empower girls to rise above disadvantage and discrimination to pursue their goals.
